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**TO: Special Olympics 5-pin bowlers, caregivers, coaches, and volunteers**

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*November 20, 2016*

- As of January 2017, BC Special Olympics Nanaimo is going to change 5-pin bowling fees from \$4/week to \$60/season (January-April, September-December, etc.).
- We are making the change to reduce the inconvenience of weekly fee collection, improve attendance, and avoid tying up lanes unnecessarily.
- The seasonal fee will be paid directly to the **Brechin Lanes staff** at the desk in the Lanes, no longer to SO coaches.
- Weekly fees will still remain \$4/week for bowling until the end of December 2016.

- Bowlers can start advance paying and reserving their spot for the January-April season to Brechin Lanes staff on **December 10** for the new season.
- Please pay in advance, if possible, as this will allow coaches and Brechin Lanes Staff to prepare team lists and avoid the early season chaos on January 7<sup>th</sup>.
- After paying the seasonal fee, athletes will be assigned a spot on a 5-person team.
- The deadline for the seasonal fee of \$60 is **February 14**. After this date, the team rosters are closed **and no new bowlers** will be allowed to join the league until the next season.



- If bowlers pay before January 31, they only have to pay the early bird seasonal fee of \$55. After that, until February 14, the fee will be \$60.
- If a bowler is aware they cannot make a Saturday during the season, they are allowed to drop in and “bowl-off” any other time that Brechin Lanes are open and lanes are available before the Saturday session. Brechin Staff will then include scores with the team scores on the following Saturday. Roll-offs must be conducted **before** missing the Saturday.
- If you have any questions about the new protocol please bring them to the attention of our head coach, Jacky Sheng, at the lanes on a Saturday.
